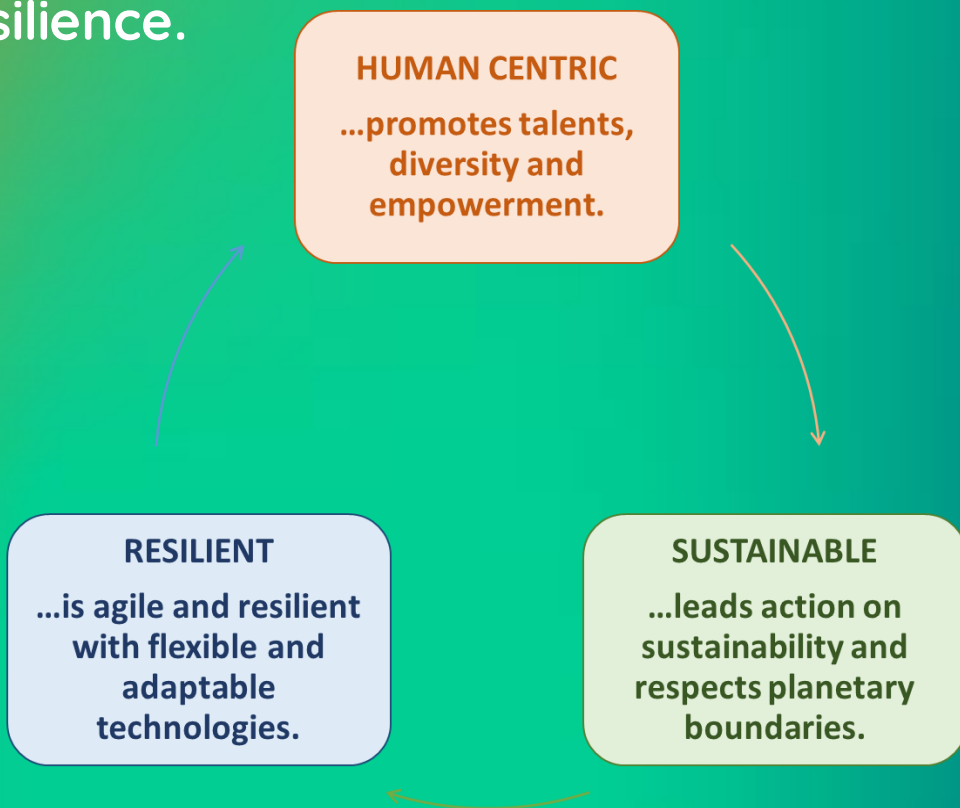
Goal



The contest aims to encourage young people to be problem solvers and change makers, to help industries improve their operations, products and services towards sustainable development.

Applicants are tasked to:

- Identify a real-life industrial challenge related to Industry 5.0, i.e. digitalization, sustainability, people-centricity and/or resilience.



- Propose a concept for an original, innovative solution that solves the identified problem in manufacturing.
- Describe the industrial challenge and pitch the solution, its benefits and costs, and future progress in a 2-minute video presentation.

Award



The winner or team will get an exclusive invitation to the World Manufacturing Forum 2023, which will be held in Italy in November.

Winners will have access to this exclusive event, an international network of possible contacts and specific activities organized by the YML Network.

They will receive an official award certificate in a dedicated ceremony during the Young Manufacturing Leaders Main Event to be held on the side-lines of the World Manufacturing Forum 2023.

All travel and accommodation expenses will be covered by the YML Network.

The winners will also receive a special prize from “Women in 3D Printing”, which is a global association dedicated to promoting, supporting, and inspiring women who are using Additive Manufacturing technologies.

Evaluation criteria



The entries will be evaluated by the Young Manufacturing Leader Network's competition committee using the following criteria:

✓ Creativity 30%

This criterion relates to:

- Originality and uniqueness of the idea,
- Critical Thinking.

✓ Impact 30%

This criterion relates to the application potential and impact of the idea.

The following aspects will be evaluated:

- Production cost/benefit analysis,
- Environmental and Social Impacts,
- Value for the end user.

✓ Video presentation 40%

This criterion relates to:

- Content clarity,
- Suitability for a general audience,
- Compelling storytelling,
- Absence of image and sound issues.

Contest rules



- The call is open until 24/09/2023 (11:59 PM CEST).
- Applicants must be members of the [YML network](#) (registration is open those between 18- and 30-year-old).
- The video, presenting the challenge and the solution, must be in English and last 2 minutes.
- The idea can be developed by a single member or a group of 1 - 3 YML members.
- By submitting a video, participants agree to the use of the materials for YML promotional purposes.
- The goal is to have a fun and promote manufacturing and technical education in general.

Video parameters



● Video file formats: MP4, WMV, AVI

● Video resolution: 1080p

● Duration: maximum of 2 minutes

● Format: 16:9 horizontal

Purpose of the personal data processing: the personal data of the Data Subject will be processed for the purposes connected and instrumental to the activities explained in the previous release and will be disseminated according to the methods equally described in the release. Personal data will also be processed to the extent that processing is necessary for obtaining consent in relation to this document and for the storage / archiving of the same.
